

 - Made primarily from waste materials.
 - Must have functional, aesthetic, or innovative value.
 - Submit a 200–300 word description on showcase day.
- Originality: Only original work; no plagiarism or pre-made items.
- Presentation:
 - Display and explain the product to the jury on the showcase day i.e. 22nd March 2025
 - Optional visual aids (charts, models, digital presentations).
- Judging Criteria:
 - Innovation (30%)
 - Practicality & Functionality (30%)
 - Sustainability Impact (20%)
 - Aesthetic Appeal (20%)

ACTIVITY 2:

NATURE PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

What to Do: Take a photo of an act of sustainability in daily life. (SOLO)


***** Examples:

- A bird is drinking from a clay pot.
- A local vegetable vendor is using paper bags.
- Rainwater harvesting setup at home.
- What to Bring: A printed or digital copy of the best photo with a short caption.



ACTIVITY 3:

GREEN ADVERTISING CHALLENGE



What to Do: Create a 30-second video ad to promote an eco-friendly product or service. (SOLO or TEAM OF 2 to 3)

★ How it works?

- Each team picks a sustainability topic (e.g., saving water, reducing plastic, etc.).
- They create and act out a fun, engaging commercial.
- What to Bring: The final creation in a pendrive and a short introduction of each team member.





ACTIVITY 4: SUSTAINABLE FASHION DIY





What to Do: Make accessories or clothes using upcycled fabric. (<u>SOLO</u>)

***** Examples:

- DIY Jewellery: Earrings from fabric scraps
- DIY Eco Bags: Convert an old T-shirt into a reusable shopping bag.
- DIY accessories: Hair scrunchies from old T-shirts
- **What to Bring:** The finished fashion item with a short write-up on its impact.

ACTIVITY 5:

MINI SKIT OR POEM ON SUSTAINABILITY



★ What to Do: Prepare a 2-minute skit or poem promoting sustainability.

(SOLO or TEAM OF 2-3)

- ***** Examples:
 - A fun role-play where plastic waste talks about its journey.
 - A poem on "The Journey of a Plastic Bottle."
- **What to Bring:** A printed copy of the script or poem.

Prize: Certificates for all participants, and the best team gets a gift hamper.



ACTIVITY 6:

DIY ECO-FRIENDLY CANDLES



★ What to Do: Make candles using leftover wax from old candles or crayons. (<u>SOLO</u>)

How to Do It:

- Melt old wax pieces.
- Pour into small containers like coconut shells or used candle jars.
- Use a cotton thread as a wick.
- **★ What to Bring:** The handmade candle and a note on how it was made.

ACTIVITY 7:

RECYCLED PAPER MAKING



★ What to Do: Make handmade paper using old paper scraps. (SOLO)

★ How to Do It:

- Blend shredded paper + water into a pulp.
- Spread the pulp thinly on a mesh or cloth and let it dry.
- Decorate it with dried flowers, seeds, or leaves.
- **What to Bring:** A sheet of handmade paper and a short explanation of the process.

Prize: Certificates for all participants, and the best team gets a gift hamper.
